## RULES FOR AWARD OF GOLD MEDALS

One University Gold Medals shall be awarded for each discipline instead of each programme run by the University to a meritorious candidate.

The following shall be criterion for award of gold Medal:

- A candidate must have a CGPA of 8.00 to be eligible for Gold Medal in Grading System and 75 % in Marking System.
- The candidate(s) must have passed the examination in the regular period of the programme in first attempt. There has been no reappear in any subject(s)/course(s) during the period of his/her study.
- In case, a candidate has passed the subject(s) after re-evaluation of the main exam then it shall be treated as single attempt. Such re-evaluated marks shall be considered for ascertaining the award of Gold Medal.
- The candidate who has got reappear on account of absence in any paper/subject in exam shall not be eligible for award of Gold Medal.
- A student who has appeared for improvement examination of any courses shall not be eligible any Gold Medal
- A student who has got grace marks in any of courses shall not be eligible for any Gold Medal.
- Student must not have been debarred/detained in any semester /Year.
- A student who has been suspended or expelled from the Hostel/University for any act of indiscipline shall not be eligible any Gold Medal.
- The final decision for award of Gold Medal shall be taken after completion of reevaluation process of the final semester examination in that particular programme.
- The candidate who secured highest CGPA among eligible candidates shall be awarded Gold Medal.
- 11. In case, two or more candidates have secured the same CGPA, the following criterion, in order of preference, shall be followed to decide the Gold Medal:

## **Grading System**

- (a) The candidate who has secured higher/highest CGPA by considering up to 3rd place of decimal of CGPA shall stand higher in rank.
- (b) The student obtaining higher SGPA in the final semester shall be eligible for the award of medal.
- (c) The student obtain higher SGPA in the previous to final semester/Year shall be eligible for the award of medal.

## **Marking System**

In case, two or more students have secured the same % marks then, the following criterion, in order of preference, shall be followed to decide the gold medal.

- (a) The student obtaining higher % marks in University Theory examination of final year shall be eligible for the award of the medal.
- (b) The student obtaining higher % marks in previous to Final Year shall be eligible for the award of the medal.
- (c) The student obtaining higher % marks in University Theory examination of final year shall be eligible for the award of the medal.

In case the two contenders have equal CGPA, then the grades in the compulsory courses shall be taken into consideration.

12. In case of program/specialization in any program, Gold Medal shall be awarded subject to minimum 10 students appeared in final year examination of the program/specialization.
