#### Moot Court & Advocacy Competitions National Moot Court Competitions

- A flagship event that attracts participation from law schools across India.

#### Intra-University Moot Court Competitions

### Supreme Court of India & High Court Visits

- Students attend live court sessions, observe landmark case hearings, and interact with sitting judges and legal practitioners.

### District Court & Family Court Visits

- On-the-ground exposure to day-to-day civil and criminal proceedings at the local judicial level enables students to witness firsthand how legal matters are handled at the grassroots.

### Legal Aid Clinics

- The School of Law has established a dedicated Legal Aid Clinic on campus to offer free legal assistance to economically and socially disadvantaged individuals. Operated in association with the DLSA, Ludhiana, the clinic provides students with opportunities to apply their legal knowledge while serving the community.

### Street Plays & Awareness Campaigns
